This building will house over 33 million items from the Library's special collections, including maps, globes, manuscripts, prints and photographs. This new facility also contains a new processing area, quarantine room and loading dock. This state-of-the-art storage unit offers environmental controls that will extend the lives of the collection items for decades.

C-CAT provided over 200 new voice and data locations as well as singlemode fiber between existing modules and new modules.
